
A paradigm shift in the world order characterized by increased instability, polarizing narratives, erosion of trust, and insecurity.





The time to act is now...







- **20**th year of publication

Immediate challenges, risks 2025

Declining optimism

Top risk concerns by time-period 2025


Short Term (2 years)

- 3. Critical change to Earth systems
- 4. Natural resource shortages




Relative severity of global risks over a 2- and 10- year period








Main risks concerning Peruvian businessmen




